## **Court Directions at Filing Hearing**

1.	The informant arrange for CCTV/BWC and other footage to be formatted in a form compatible with the <b>Magistrates' Court technology standards</b> and served with the HUB	
	Within 7 days, the informant make an appointment for the lodgement of <u>electronic/digital items</u> for analysis with <b>Digital Forensics</b> (e.g. computers, mobile phones etc.).	
2.	And, if the matter is a <u>sex offence and the complainant is a child or cognitively impaired,</u> the informant:	П
	• advise Digital Forensics that the complainant is a child or cognitively impaired.	
	• further advise Digital Forensics if the child complainant is under 12 years of age.	
	Within 7 days, the informant make an appointment for the lodgement of exhibits with the <b>VFSD/AFP Forensics</b> for forensic analysis.	
3.	And, if the matter is a <u>sex offence and the complainant is a child or cognitively impaired</u> , the informant:	
	• advise VFSD /AFP Forensics that the complainant is a child or cognitively impaired.	
	• further advise VFSD /AFP Forensics if the child complainant is under 12 years of age.	
4.	Within 7 days, the informant, request a DNA Case Summary	
5.	Within 7 days, the informant, request from <b>VFSD/AFP Forensics</b> a botanist's forensic report as to the anticipated <b>yield of cannabis</b> seized	
6.	Within 7 days, the informant request <b>VFSD/AFP Forensics</b> to conduct <b>analysis of drugs</b> seized to determine whether a <b>commercial quantity</b> exists.	
7.	Within 7 days, the informant make an appointment with <b>Digital Forensics</b> to lodge <b>TI/listening device items for transcription,</b> or the <b>AFP</b> otherwise make a request for that transcription.	
8.	The informant arrange for an analysis of a representative sample of the child abuse material seized in accordance with the <b>INTERPOL baseline classification of child abuse material.</b>	
9.	The informant file with the Court and serve on the prosecution and the accused, a HUB prepared in accordance with s110 of the Criminal Procedure Act 2009 (CPA) in an electronic form and in accordance with any directions made at the filing hearing.
